



Our Story

Rockwood Farm is owned by Richard and Mary Woodger and was started in 1969 and they have two sons who are active in the operation today with vested interest in the renewable energy system.

The dairy is presently milking 350 cows with 300 replacements in all stages. The farm has 6 full time employees and ships 25,000



lbs. of milk daily. In addition to the milking operation, the farm actively grows 500 acres of corn and 280 acres of hay. Both of these crops are harvested to feed the cows. Currently, the farm has storage facility for 3.8 million gallons of manure.

Rockwood Farm has partnered with Ag Grid LLC to form a special purpose company named, Rockwood-Ag Grid LLC, for ownership of and investment in the digester system installation.

The Woodger family is looking forward to hosting dairy farmers across the Northeast at their farm on October 8, 2021 where you can learn more about their renewable energy project as well as join other farmers for a great social networking opportunity.
